WHERE ARE WE GOING?:

Speakers will include: Bryce Crawford, Philip Anthony Mitchell, Jentezen Franklin, Reggie Dabbs, & Girls Gone Bible. Worship will be lead by Free Chapel Music.

WHEN & HOW ARE WE GETTING THERE?

Level Up Youth will be riding on a Trailway bus to the event. We will leave the Word of Grace parking lot **Thursday, June 25th, 2026, @ 5AM SHARP**, so that we will arrive at the Gas South Arena that afternoon in time for the first event. The conference will start Thursday at 7pm, and end Saturday around 5p. Our group will stay the night and travel home Sunday. We should arrive back at the Word of Grace parking lot between 4:30p & 5:30p on SUNDAY, June 28th, 2026. The bus will be taking us to and from all of the stops on our trip.

TELL ME MORE ABOUT THE HOTEL:

While attending the conference we will be staying at the Hampton Inn & Suites in John's Creek, GA. There will be 1 adult & 3 students of the same gender in each room.

FOOD:

There will be a variety of different locations to eat at throughout our trip. The price of all meals is included in the fees. Each student will receive their budgeted allotment per stop. Some examples of expected stops include: Chick-Fil-A, Buc-ee's, Zaxby's, & pizza, with several stops offering multiple choices. Breakfast will be at the hotel Friday - Sunday. The youth conference will have concessions but these are card only snack vendors and are not included in the fee. Your student will have enough to buy a normal size meal at each stop. If you want them to have the ability to purchase upgraded or more expensive choices, please consider sending extra cash for that purpose. Students will get to keep any change leftover from their food budget for the next stop, and so on with the exception of pizza or joint orders that will happen at least twice during the trip.

ABOUT THE COST:

How much will it cost?

\$280 + Conference Ticket

\$280 will cover expenses for food & the hotel. Tickets for the event vary by date of purchase. (\$80 - \$105, see below for dates.)

The conference ticket deposit was due when the registration pamphlet is turned in, tickets are non-refundable.

(Level Up Youth will purchase the tickets so we can all get the group price.)

TICKET PRICES ONLY! This was due as a deposit when the pamphlet was turned in.

Pay deposit by:

February 4th: \$80 April 1st: \$90 May 27th: \$105

After June 5: \$110 (If tickets are still available.)

*Due to the generosity of others our bus fee has been covered!

DOES MY TEEN NEED ADDITIONAL MONEY?

Consider sending some extra money with your student to purchase merchandise at the conference and other snack/shopping opportunities may become available (Buc-ee's anyone?). The money sent for this purpose will be the responsibility of your teen. Keep in mind that we have charged a fee to cover a normal meal. We will only give your student their allotted amount at each food stop. This will make sure no one goes without food, etc. If your student want to purchase food above their budget, that is fine as long as they have the money on them to cover the excess. Students meal budget averages \$13 - \$15 depending on the planned stop. Most breakfasts are included in the hotel fee.

ABOUT THE PAPERWORK:

When are my forms/waivers due in?

A.S.A.P! Students applications and release waivers will be emailed once the ticket is paid for and form on pamphlet is turned in. Pamphlets are available at the receptionist desk in the church foyer. You may also ask one of our Level Up Leaders to help you get one. To help students afford the trip please feel free to make payments at any time at the front desk. The total must be paid no later than Wednesday night June 3rd. If additional tickets are still available for purchase, there is still room on the bus, & at the hotel, last minute youth may be signed up to attend at the conference if special permission is given by Pastor Jake Dardar.

MAY MY STUDENT BRING THEIR OWN SNACKS?

They may, but please use discretion. Small, simple snacks are the best. (i.e.: If you wouldn't allow it on your family vacation, please don't send it with them!) Students will have several opportunities to purchase small snacks along the way. They must keep their snacks in tightly SEALED containers at all times to avoid being messy. If snacks are not properly discarded and cared for they may be confiscated.

AND DRINKS?

Drinks must be contained in a closable container (i.e.: bottled with screw-on cap) Canned drinks and bag drinks tend to get spilled on other students, their belongings, and on carpet. Please help us to be tidy. We recommend students BRING A refillable WATER BOTTLE WITH THEIR NAME ON IT!

WHO WILL BE THE CHAPERONES?

There will be adult chaperones from our Level Up Team.

MAY I CONTACT MY STUDENT?

YES, PLEASE UNDERSTAND THEY MAY NOT BE ABLE TO SPEAK WITH YOU DURING CONFERENCE EVENTS.

WHAT ABOUT CELL PHONES?

Students are allowed to carry cell phones with them at all times. However, cell phones will be the individual responsibility of the person who owns them. Due to the volume level at such events, and so others do not miss out on the events, calls will be limited during the conference times.

Do Not Bring:

Inappropriate Video Games
Immodest Clothing
Immodest Swim-wear
(a colored t-shirt must be worn to cover a 2 piece)
Water Guns/Balloons
Weapons or Ammo
Fireworks
Alcohol
Skateboards/Roller Blades
Valuables
Large amounts of Money
LOUD devices, such as alarms, airhorns, whistles, or the like.

Dress Code

We ask that you pack and wear modest clothing and understand this dress code applies to both males and females who attend.

- T-shirts, shorts, and tennis shoes are great for most activities.
- Modest shorts/skirts. (Your shirt should not cover up your shorts where they cannot be easily seen.) If in doubt about length, please ask one of the church's youth staff.
- No tight shirts, shorts, or skirts.
- Leggings and biker shorts must be covered by shorts, a skirt, a dress, or a long t-shirt.
- No bare midriffs. (Including swimsuits)
- No visible boxers, briefs, or bralettes.
- No clothing with references to drugs, alcohol, sex, or profanity.
- No low-cut tops or tanks in the front or sides.
- Accepted swimsuits include: tankinis, modest one pieces, modest trunks, or bikinis covered by a colored shirt, and shorts.
